For the reasons set forth in the Memorandum Opinion accompanying this Order, it is hereby: **ORDERED** that petitioner's Motion for Default Judgment [Dkt. # 17] is **GRANTED**; it is further

ORDERED that default judgment be entered against respondent; it is further

ORDERED that the arbitral award set out in petitioner's Petition to Confirm Arbitral Award [Dkt. # 1] is hereby recognized and confirmed and entered as a judgment in favor of petitioner and against respondent by the Clerk of the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in the same manner and with the same force and effect as if the award were a final judgment of this Court; and it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that judgment be entered in favor of petitioner DIGOIL in the following amounts and against respondent the Democratic Republic of the Congo in the following amounts:

1. \$617,400,178 in damages, together with prejudgment interest calculated at 5.35%, compounded annually from the date of the award until today; and

2. \$1,109,933.62 in legal representation costs and expenses, together with prejudgment interest calculated at 5.35%, compounded annually from the date of the award until today; and

3. \$760,000 in arbitration costs, together with prejudgment interest calculated at 5.35%, compounded annually from the date of the award until today; and

4. Postjudgment interest shall run from the date of this Judgment at the statutory rate specified at 28 U.S.C. § 1961.
